Anatomy

The study of the structure of the human body and its parts.

Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its parts.

Structural levels

Studying the human body at the structural level involves understanding the following levels:

- 1. **Chemical level** - study of the chemical composition of the body.
- 2. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of cells.
- 3. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of tissues.
- 4. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of organs.
- 5. **System level** - study of the structure and function of body systems.
- 6. **Organism level** - study of the structure and function of the whole body.

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the body.



Characteristics of cells

All cells are eukaryotic and have a nucleus.

Cells are specialized to perform specific functions.

Cells are surrounded by a cell membrane.

Cells are capable of self-renewal.

Cells are capable of communication.

Cells are capable of responding to their environment.

Cells are capable of maintaining homeostasis.

Cells are capable of reproducing.

Cells are capable of growing.

Cells are capable of dying.

Cells are capable of moving.

Cells are capable of sensing.

Cells are capable of thinking.

Cells are capable of feeling.

Cells are capable of knowing.

Cells are capable of loving.

Cells are capable of everything.

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ORGANS

Organs are structures made up of different types of tissues.

Organs perform specific functions in the body.

Organs are specialized to perform specific functions.

Organs are surrounded by a layer of connective tissue.

Organs are capable of self-renewal.

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SYSTEMS

Systems are groups of organs that work together to perform a specific function.

Systems are specialized to perform specific functions.

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Digestive system

The digestive system is responsible for breaking down food into nutrients that can be absorbed by the body.

The digestive system consists of the mouth, esophagus, stomach, and intestines.
