generally recuperative metaphysical cycle Such solitude is intentional a critical phase in the live withdraw live again cycle of spiritual refreshment A recuperative isolation can be experienced daily if one is discriminating in how their time is spent but is usually gained more intensely over long purposefully reclusive periods.
