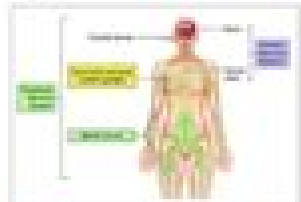

8. Unipolar neurons: have one dendrite and one axon.

9. Pseudounipolar neurons: have one long process that branches into two.

10. Golgi neurons: have a Golgi apparatus in the cell body.

11. Mitochondrial neurons: have mitochondria in the cell body.

12. Endoplasmic reticulum neurons: have endoplasmic reticulum in the cell body.

13. Nucleus neurons: have a nucleus in the cell body.

14. Cytoplasm neurons: have cytoplasm in the cell body.

15. Membrane neurons: have a membrane in the cell body.

16. Organelle neurons: have organelles in the cell body.

17. Protein neurons: have proteins in the cell body.
