- Anatomical position -
 - In this position, the body is:
 - Upright
 - Feet slightly apart
 - Arms at the sides
 - Palms turned towards the front of the body
 - Thumbs away from the body
 - Heels are raised to show the bottom of the feet



(a) Ambertion/Ventral

- (b) Posterion/Dominic
- Directional terms allow us to explain where one body structure is in relation to another
 - Example: the ears are lateral to the nose
 - Meaning that the ears are located on the right and left side of the nose
 - Regional terms used to designate specific areas within these major body divisions
 - Axial makes up the main axis of our body and includes the head, neck, and trunk
 - Appendicular consists of the appendages which are attached to the body's axis
- Planes a division of the body in which it is divided along a flat surface called a plane
 - The most frequently used planes are the sagittal, frontal, and transverse
 - Sagittal plane a vertical plane that divides the body into right and left
