

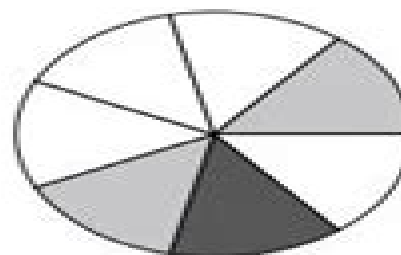

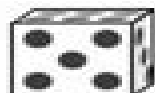
Use each diagram to solve the problems.

- 5) If you spun the spinner 1 time, what is the probability of landing on either a white piece or a black piece?



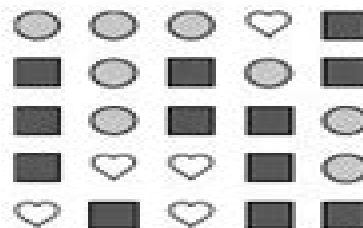
