Written by Lewis Carroll in 1864, Alice's adventures in Wonderland is about a small girl who journeys through many strange lands meeting many curious characters along her way.

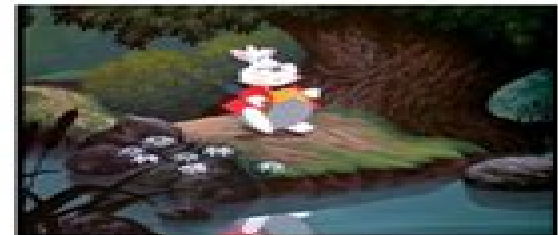
Our story begins on warm summers day. Alice was happily daydreaming when suddenly something caught her attention.

Franziska Schütze, 2014-04-11 Inhaltsangabe Introduction Every thing s got a moral if only you can find it Lewis Carroll 1865 In 2015 the first edition of Alice in Wonderland will have its 150th anniversary The novel as well as its sequel Through the Looking Glass and What Alice Found There have been read by people of all ages and all origins ever since Due to the widespread success of the literary work Lewis Carroll s novels have not only been illustrated by hundreds of artists but also frequently adapted for film theatre opera music and other forms of art Among these numerous adaptations are two motion pictures produced by the Walt Disney Company which is known for warm hearted movies for audiences of all ages The relationship between Alice in Wonderland and Walt Disney even dates back to 1923 when he founded the famous film studio due to a distribution contract for his first completed short film called Alice s Wonderland This thesis however focuses on the Disney adaptation from 1951 a 2 D cartoon animation as well as the most recent film adaptation from 2010 a combination of live action film and computer generated animation Thus the main part of this thesis constitutes a comparative analysis of both adaptations regarding the following aspects the evolution of the visualisations the different characters of the heroine Alice the influences of Walt Disney and Tim Burton on the story lines and the styles of the adaptations and the responses to both films Thereby the following research questions should be answered What are the specificities of Carroll s novels Why did it attract so many filmmakers Why did both adaptations employ the medium of animation Did the medium get implemented successfully How did Walt Disney and Tim Burton affect the story lines and the styles of the adaptations How did the heroine s character change under their influence How did the audiences react to the adaptations What are the reasons for that The first theoretical part hence starts with a description of the literary model which aims at defining the novels specificities respectively the essence Carroll tried to convey Chapter 2 outlines the most important issues of today s adaptation discourse since the theory of adaptation serves as the theoretical basis for the comparative analysis In chapter 3 an overview of the medium of animation will be given including the medium s possibilities and challenges as well as its techniques With Alice's Wonderland Catherine Nichols, 2014-11-18 Presents a history of Alice s adventures in Wonderland discussing works that were inspired by Lewis Carroll s classic tale Animating the Victorians Patrick C. biographies and intervening adaptations To reveal that process Fleming draws on preproduction reports press releases and unfinished drafts including materials in the Walt Disney Company Archives some of which have not yet been discussed in print But the relationship between Disney and the Victorians goes beyond adaptations Walt Disney himself had a similar career to the Victorian author entrepreneur Charles Dickens Linking the Disney Princess franchise to Victorian ideologies shows how gender and sexuality are constantly being renegotiated Disney s animated musicals theme parks copyright practices and even marketing campaigns depend on cultural assumptions legal frameworks and media technologies that emerged in nineteenth century England Moreover Disney s adaptations influence modern students and scholars of the Victorian period By applying scholarship in Victorian studies to a global company Fleming shows how institutions mediate our understanding of the past and demonstrates the continued relevance of literary studies in a corporate media age
