



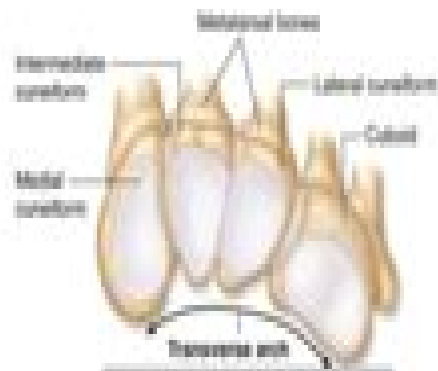
(a) Lateral aspect of right foot
