Factoring:

Look to see if there is a GCF (protect common factor) first. $ab+ac = a(b+c)$

$$x^2 - a^2 = (x-a)(x+a)$$

$$(x+a)^2 = x^2 + 2ax + a^2$$

$$(x-a)^2 = x^2 - 2ax + a^2$$

Factor by Grouping:

$$x^3 + 2x^2 - 3x - 6$$

$$(x^3 + 2x^2) + (-3x - 6) \text{ group}$$

$$x^2(x+2) - 3(x+2) \text{ factor each}$$

$$(x^2 - 3)(x+2) \text{ factor}$$

Exponentials: $e^x = \exp(x)$

$$b^x = b^y \rightarrow x = y \quad (b > 0 \text{ and } b \neq 1)$$

If the bases are the same, set the exponents equal and solve.

Solving exponential equations:

1. Isolate exponential expression.
2. Take log or ln of both sides.
3. Solve for the variable.

ln(x) and e^x are inverse functions

$$\ln e^x = x \quad e^{\ln x} = x$$

$$\ln e = 1 \quad e^{\ln 4} = 4$$

$$e^{\ln x} = e^{\ln y} = y$$

Quadratic Equations: $ax^2 + bx + c = 0$ (a ≠ 0)

Solve by factoring, completing the square, quadratic formula.

$$b^2 - 4ac > 0 \text{ two real unequal roots}$$

$$b^2 - 4ac = 0 \text{ repeated real roots}$$

$$b^2 - 4ac < 0 \text{ two complex roots}$$

Square root property: If $x^2 = a$, then $x = \pm\sqrt{a}$

Completing the square: $x^2 + 2x + 5 = 0$

1. If other than one, divide by coefficient of x^2
2. Move constant term to other side $x^2 + 2x = -5$
3. Take half of coefficient of x, square it, add to both sides

$$x^2 + 2x + 1 = -5 + 1$$

$$(x+1)^2 = -4$$

4. Factor perfect square on left side $(x+1)^2 = -4$

5. Use square root property to solve and get two answers. $x = -1 \pm 2i$

Sum of roots: $x_1 + x_2 = -\frac{b}{a}$ Product of roots: $x_1 x_2 = \frac{c}{a}$

Inequalities: $x^2 + x - 12 \leq 0$ Change to $=$, factor, locate critical points on number line, check each section.

$$(x+4)(x-3) = 0$$

$$x = -4, x = 3$$



ANSWER: $-4 \leq x \leq 3$ or $[-4, 3]$ (in interval notation)

3. Solve for x.

$$\text{Ex. } |2x-1| = x+1$$

Negative case: set = to negation of each term on the right

Less than arrows in towards each other "AND"
Greater than arrows away from each other "OR"

Solving Linear/Quadratic Systems:

$$y = 2x^2 - 6x + 5$$

$$y - 2 = x$$

$$y - 2 = x$$

1. Set both equations to "y=" form.

2. Then set both equations equal to each other.

3. Solve the remaining quadratic equation for the x values.

4. Substitute x back in to find y values.

$$2x^2 - 6x + 5 = x + 2$$

$$2x^2 - 7x + 3 = 0$$

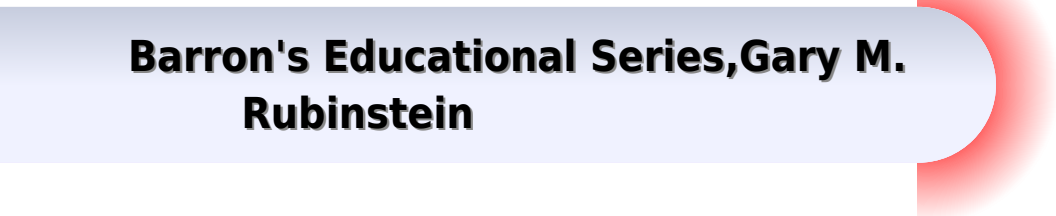
