Physiology

The scientific study of the function of the human body

Structural levels

Also known as the levels of organization of the human body

- 1. Chemical level - study of the chemical composition of the body
- 2. Cellular level - study of the structure and function of cells
- 3. Tissue level - study of the structure and function of tissues
- 4. Organ level - study of the structure and function of organs
- 5. System level - study of the structure and function of body systems
- 6. Organism level - study of the structure and function of the whole body

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the body



Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids

Extracellular fluid - fluid outside the cell

Intracellular fluid - fluid inside the cell

Interstitial fluid - fluid between cells

Blood plasma - fluid part of blood

Organic fluids - fluids containing organic molecules

Inorganic fluids - fluids containing inorganic molecules

Electrolytes - substances that conduct electricity

Non-electrolytes - substances that do not conduct electricity

Acids - substances that release hydrogen ions

Bases - substances that accept hydrogen ions

pH - measure of acidity or alkalinity

Homeostasis - the body's ability to maintain a stable internal environment

Feedback loops - mechanisms that regulate homeostasis

Positive feedback - amplifies a response

Negative feedback - reduces a response

Set point - the desired level of a variable

Range - the acceptable range of a variable

Stimulus - a change in the environment that triggers a response

Receptor - a structure that detects a stimulus

Control center - a structure that processes information and issues orders

Effector - a structure that carries out a response

Response - a change in the body that results from a stimulus

Homeostatic imbalance - a failure of the body to maintain homeostasis

Disease - a disorder that affects the normal function of the body

Disorder - a condition that causes abnormality

Symptom - a sign or sensation that indicates a problem

Sign - an objective indication of a problem

Symptom - a subjective indication of a problem

Diagnosis - the identification of a disease or condition

Treatment - a course of action to cure or manage a disease

Prognosis - a prediction of the outcome of a disease

Prevention - measures taken to avoid a disease

Health - a state of complete physical, mental, and social well-being

Wellness - a state of being in good health

Quality of life - a measure of a person's overall well-being

Life expectancy - the average number of years a person is expected to live

Mortality rate - the number of deaths per 1,000 people per year

Morbidity rate - the number of cases of a disease per 1,000 people per year

Prevalence - the number of cases of a disease at a given time

Incidence - the number of new cases of a disease at a given time

Risk factor - a characteristic that increases the chance of a disease

Protective factor - a characteristic that decreases the chance of a disease

Genetics - the study of heredity and the variation of inherited traits

Chromosomes - structures that carry genetic information

Genes - units of heredity that determine traits

Alleles - different forms of a gene

Dominant allele - an allele that is expressed in the heterozygous state

Recessive allele - an allele that is not expressed in the heterozygous state

CELLS

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the body

Prokaryotic cells - cells without a nucleus

Eukaryotic cells - cells with a nucleus

Animal cells - cells without cell walls

Plant cells - cells with cell walls

Fungal cells - cells with cell walls and nuclei

Bacterial cells - cells without nuclei

Viral cells - cells without cellular structure

Prion - a protein that causes disease

Cell membrane - a barrier that separates the cell from its environment

Cell wall - a rigid structure that surrounds the cell

Cellular organelles - structures within the cell that perform specific functions

Nucleus - the control center of the cell

Chromatin - DNA and associated proteins

Chromosome - a structure of DNA and proteins

Centrioles - structures that organize microtubules

Microtubules - protein fibers that form the cell's internal framework

Microfilaments - protein fibers that are involved in cell movement

Intermediate filaments - protein fibers that provide structural support

Plasma membrane - the boundary between the cell and its environment

Cell junctions - structures that connect adjacent cells

Desmosomes - structures that anchor cells to each other

Gap junctions - structures that allow communication between cells

hemidesmosomes - structures that anchor cells to the extracellular matrix

Plasmodesmata - structures that connect the cytoplasm of adjacent cells

Exocytosis - the process of moving materials out of the cell

Endocytosis - the process of moving materials into the cell

Phagocytosis - the process of engulfing large particles

Pinocytosis - the process of taking in small molecules

Osmosis - the movement of water across a semipermeable membrane

Diffusion - the movement of molecules from high to low concentration

Active transport - the movement of molecules against their concentration gradient

Passive transport - the movement of molecules down their concentration gradient

Facilitated diffusion - the movement of molecules through a protein channel

Osmotic pressure - the pressure that must be applied to prevent osmosis

Tonicity - the relative concentration of solutes in a solution

Isotonic - a solution with the same concentration of solutes as the cell

Hypertonic - a solution with a higher concentration of solutes than the cell

Hypotonic - a solution with a lower concentration of solutes than the cell

Cell lysis - the bursting of a cell due to osmosis

Cell crenation - the shriveling of a cell due to osmosis

Cell death - the end of a cell's life

Apoptosis - the process of programmed cell death

Necrosis - the death of a cell due to injury or disease

Autophagy - the process of breaking down and recycling cellular components

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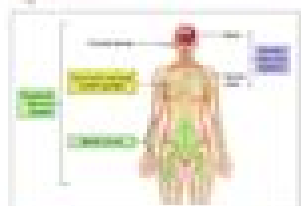
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RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

Functions

- 1. Ventilation - the process of moving air in and out of the lungs
- 2. External respiration - the exchange of gases between the lungs and the blood
- 3. Internal respiration - the exchange of gases between the blood and the cells
- 4. Gas transport - the movement of gases through the blood
- 5. pH regulation - the maintenance of the body's acid-base balance



Structure

The respiratory system is composed of the following structures:

Nasal cavity - the space inside the nose

Oral cavity - the space inside the mouth

Pharynx - the space at the back of the throat

Larynx - the voice box

Trachea - the windpipe

Bronchi - the airways that lead to the lungs

Alveoli - the small air sacs where gas exchange occurs

Diaphragm - the muscle that contracts and relaxes to breathe

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

The respiratory system is responsible for the exchange of gases between the lungs and the blood



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Diaphragm - the muscle that contracts and relaxes to breathe

Respiratory muscles - the muscles that contract and relax to breathe

Respiratory center - the part of the brain that controls breathing

Chemoreceptors - the sensors that detect changes in blood gas levels

Osmoreceptors - the sensors that detect changes in blood osmolarity

Baroreceptors - the sensors that detect changes in blood pressure

Thermoreceptors - the sensors that detect changes in body temperature

Pain receptors - the sensors that detect pain

Interoceptors - the sensors that detect internal body states

Proprioceptors - the sensors that detect body position and movement

Exteroceptors - the sensors that detect external stimuli
