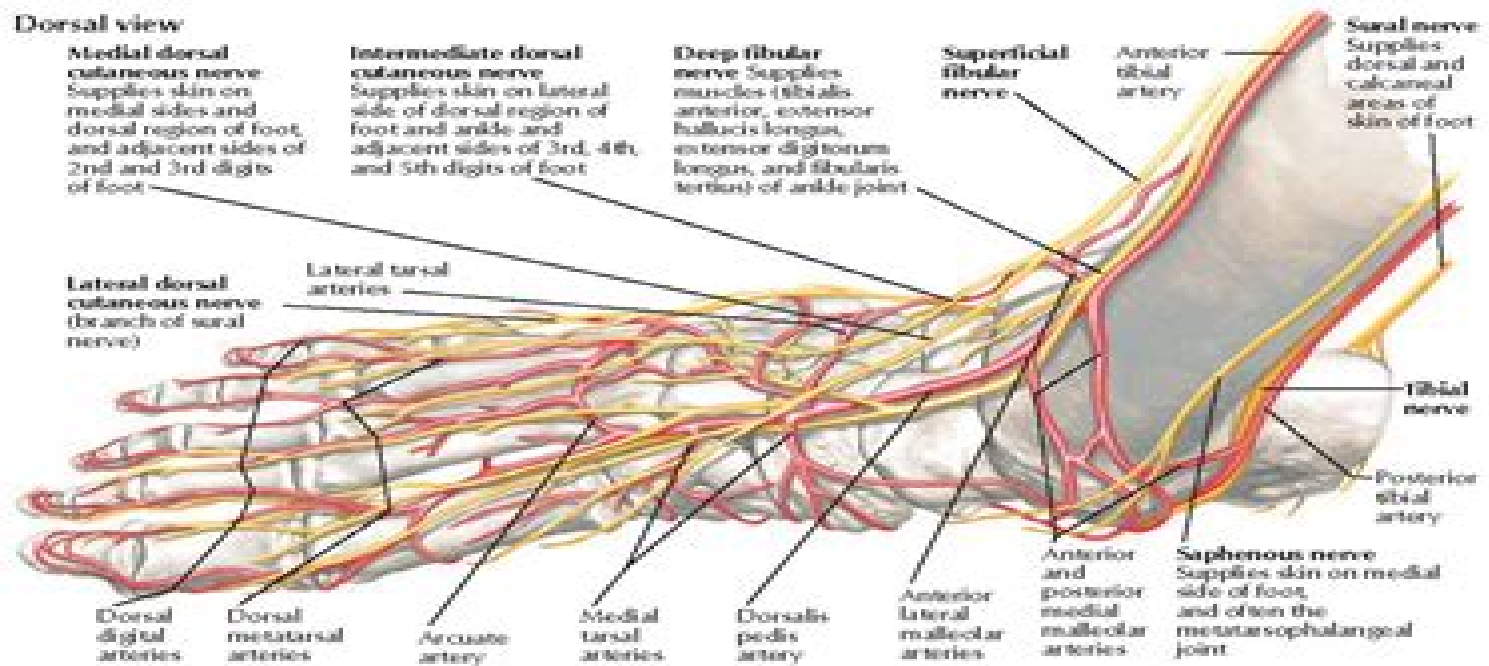
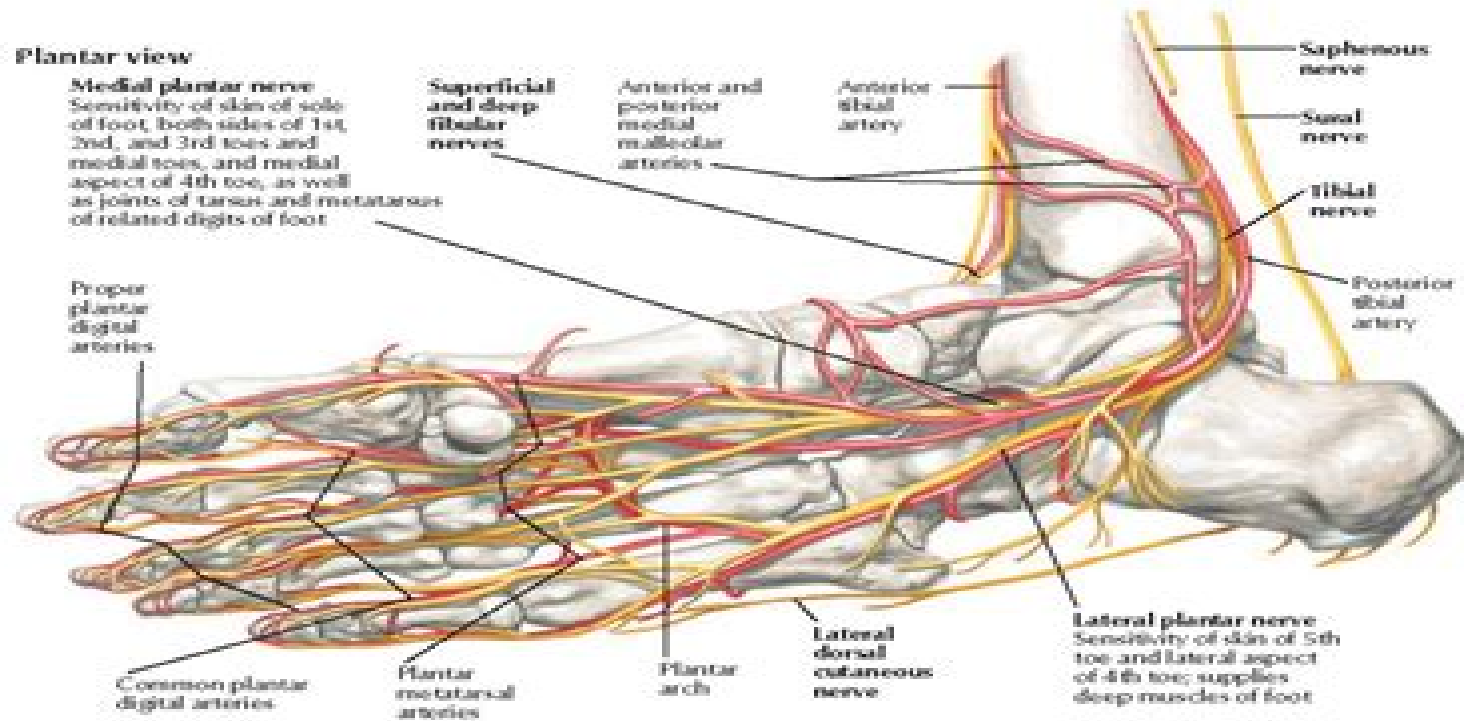


Dorsal view
