If students scored in the orange, a Survey Level Assessment will need to be completed to determine the appropriate grade level and probe to be used. Be sure to start with the easiest measure that students need to master, and move to the harder measures as Foundational skills are mastered. Students scoring in the yellow will most likely be progress monitored on grade level.

Progress Monitoring is completed in conjunction with interventions
that are working on those skills being monitored on a weekly basis.*
