This specific structure seared towards the audience was the main reason why King impacted Americans across the country and not just at the murch. These different appeals mixed within the audience to help King influence his purpose of racial equality as each type of person could relate to his moving weeds. Through the emotional engagement King had with the audience, he was most definitely able to gain a substantial amount of credibility. Consistently relating back to the phrase "one hundred years later", he directly
