On the whole, these articles should be understandable to mathematics students in their first specialization years, to graduates from other mathematical areas, and depending on the specific subject, to specialists in other domains of science, engineers, and teachers of mathematics. These articles treat their material at a fairly general level and aim to give an idea of the kind of problems, techniques, and concepts involved in the area in question. They also contain background and motivation rather than precise statements of precise theorems with detailed definitions and technical details on how to carry out proofs and constructions. The second kind of article, of medium length, contains more detailed concrete problems, results, and techniques.
