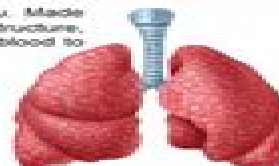

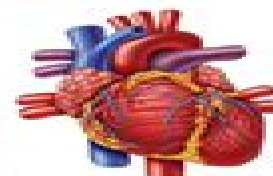
BRAIN: The control centre of the body regulates other organ system, control sensory and motor functions.

EYES: Helps you see the world around you.

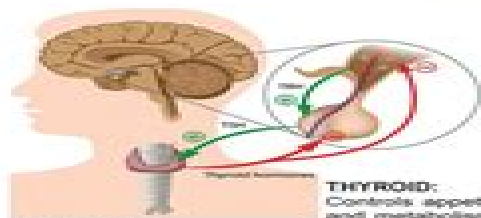


NOSE: Passage way for air that lets you smell things around you and helps in breathing.

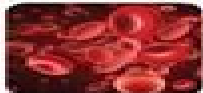


EARS: Helps you hear the world around you.

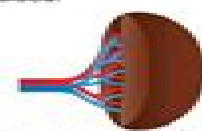
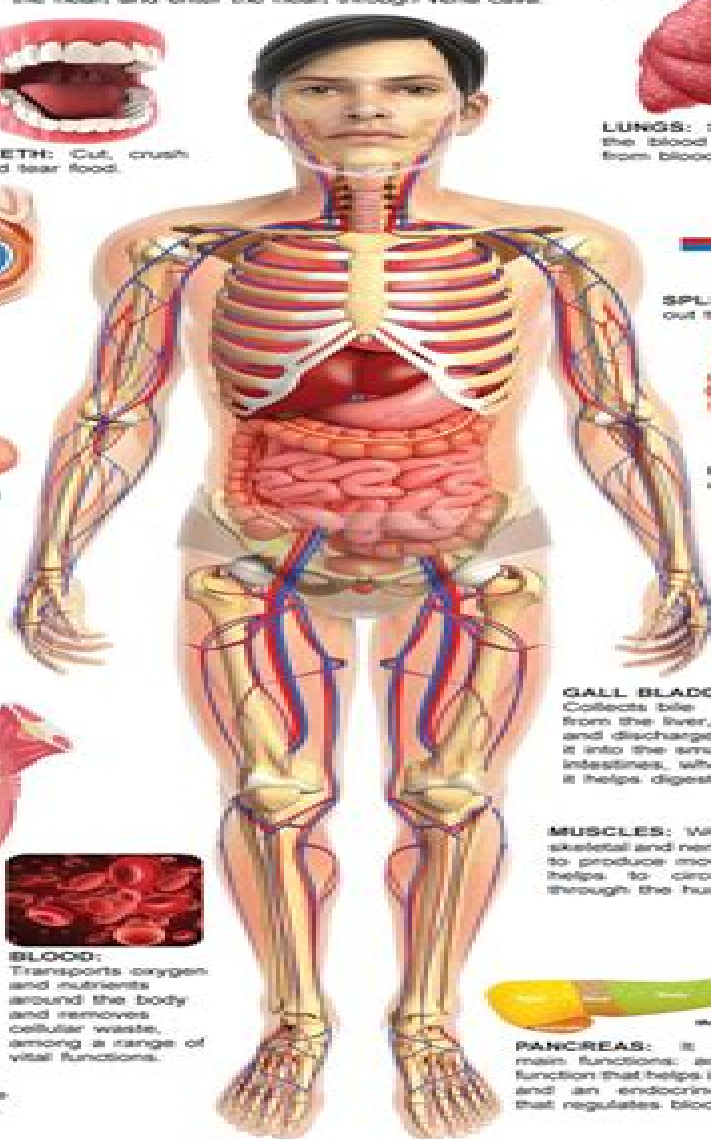
TONGUE: Help detect and transmit taste signals to the brain. The tongue is vital for chewing and swallowing food, as well as for speech.

SPLEEN: Helps to filter out toxins in the blood.

INTESTINE: Helps to digest the food.



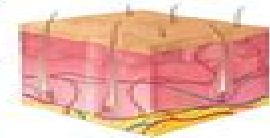
URINARY SYSTEM: Removes wastes from blood, regulates concentration of body fluids.



LIVER: Removes toxins from the blood, produces bile that help in digestion.

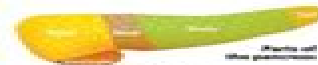


GALL BLADDER: Collects bile from the liver, and discharges it into the small intestines, where it helps digest fat.

PANCREAS: It has two main functions: an exocrine function that helps in digestion and an endocrine function that regulates blood sugar.
