Analysis Of Afrikaans Short Story Benedicta:

The South African Short Story in English, 1920-2010 Marta Fossati, 2024-09-05 Through detailed close readings alongside investigations into the history of print culture Marta Fossati traces the development of the South African short story in English from the late 1920s to the first decade of the twenty first century She examines a selection of short stories by important Black South African writers Rolfes and Herbert Dhlomo Peter Abrahams Can Themba Alex La Guma Mtutuzeli Matshoba Ahmed Essop and Zo Wicomb with an alertness to the dialogue between ethics and aesthetics performed by these texts This new history of Black short fiction problematises and interrogates the often polarised readings of Black literature in South Africa that can be torn between notions of literariness protest and journalism Due to material constraints short fiction in South Africa circulated first and foremost through local print media which Fossati analyses in detail to show the cross fertilisation between journalism and the short story While rooted in the South African context the short stories considered also hold a translocal dimension allowing us to explore the ethical and aesthetic practice of intertextuality These are writings that complicate the aesthetics ethics binary generic classifications and the categories of the literary and the political Theoretically eclectic in its approach although largely underpinned by a narratological analysis *The South African Short Story in English 1920 2010 When Aesthetics Meets Ethics* offers a fresh perspective on the South African short story in English spotlighting several hitherto marginalised figures in South African literary studies

,1962 **Children's Literature Abstracts**,1993 **Media in Postapartheid South Africa** Sean Jacobs,2019-03-11 In *Media in Postapartheid South Africa* author Sean Jacobs turns to media politics and the consumption of media as a way to understand recent political developments in South Africa and their relations with the African continent and the world Jacobs looks at how mass media define the physical and human geography of the society and what it means for comprehending changing notions of citizenship in postapartheid South Africa Jacobs claims that the media have unprecedented control over the distribution of public goods rights claims and South Africa's integration into the global political economy in ways that were impossible under the state controlled media that dominated the apartheid years Jacobs takes a probing look at television commercials and the representation of South Africans reality television shows and South African continental expansion soap operas and postapartheid identity politics and the internet as a space for reassertions and reconfigurations of identity As South Africa becomes more integrated into the global economy Jacobs argues that local media have more weight in shaping how consumers view these products in unexpected and consequential ways

The second, much longer part, consists of entries grouped by language of origin; some are devoted to individual texts, e.g. the Thousand and One Nights, or writers, e.g. Ibsen, Proust, but the majority offer a critical overview of a genre, e.g. Chinese poetry, Spanish Golden Age drama, or of a national literature, e.g. Hungarian, Scottish Gaelic. There is a selective bibliography for each entry and an index of authors and translators.

Translation Revision and Post-editing Maarit Koponen, Brian Mossop, Isabelle S. Robert, Giovanna Scocchera, 2020-10-26. Translation Revision and Post editing looks at the apparently dissolving boundary between correcting translations generated by human brains and those generated by machines. It presents new research on post editing and revision in government and corporate translation departments, translation agencies, the literary publishing sector, and the volunteer sector, as well as on training in both types of translation checking work. This collection includes empirical studies based on surveys, interviews, and keystroke logging, as well as more theoretical contributions questioning such traditional distinctions as translating versus editing. The chapters discuss revision and post editing involving eight languages: Afrikaans, Catalan, Dutch, English, Finnish, French, German, and Spanish. Among the topics covered are translator-reviser relations and revising post editing by non-professionals.
