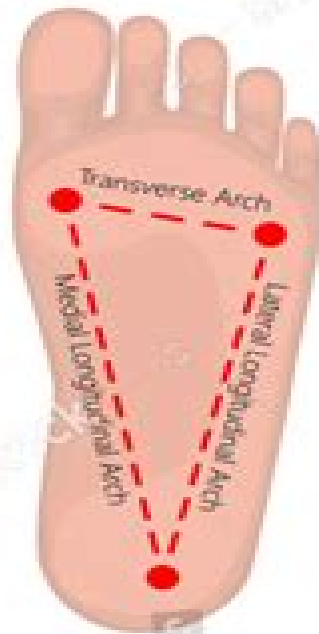
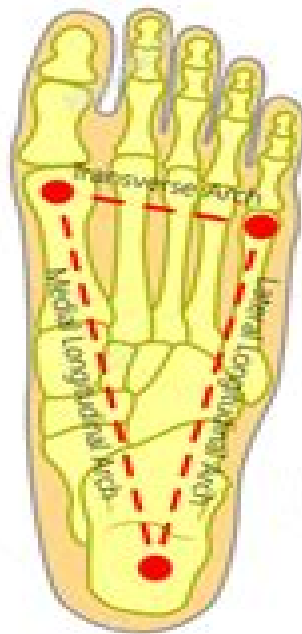

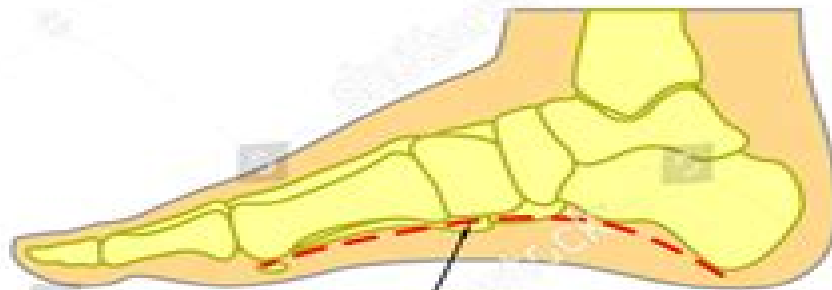
Foot
(bottom view)



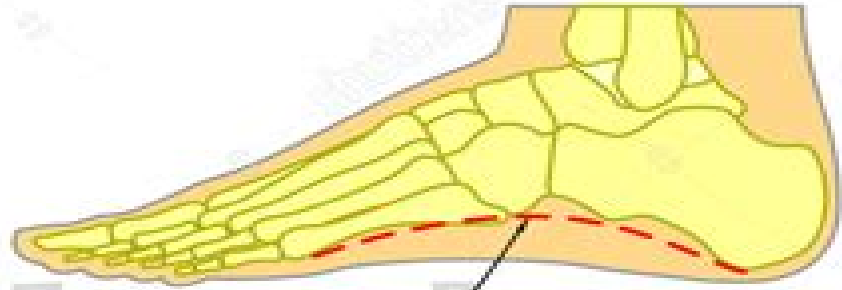
Transverse Arch
