Rosenbaum, 2019-06-30 A Concordance to the Poems of Emily Dickinson is the third volume in the distinguished series Cornell Concordances Like the others it was programmed on an IBM 704 electronic computer and provides an alphabetical list of all significant words each word given in context In order to provide variants it was based on Thomas H Johnson s three volume edition of all the known texts of Emily Dickinson s poems Included are an analytical preface by the editor and an index of words in the order of frequency *The Complete Works of W. H. Auden: Poems, Volume II* W. H. Auden, 2022-06-14 The second of two volumes of the eagerly anticipated first complete edition of Auden s poems including some that have never been published before W H Auden 1907 1973 is one of the greatest poets of the twentieth century and his reputation has only grown since his death Published on the hundredth anniversary of the year in which he began to write poetry this is the second volume of the first complete edition of Auden s poems Edited introduced and annotated by renowned Auden scholar Edward Mendelson this definitive edition includes all the poems Auden wrote for publication in their original texts and all his later revised versions as well as poems and songs he never published some of them printed here for the first time This volume follows Auden as a mature artist containing all the poems that he published or submitted for publication from 1940 until his death in 1973 at age sixty six This includes all his poetry collections from this period from *The Double Man* 1941 through *Epistle to a Godson* 1972 The volume also features an edited version of his incomplete posthumous book *Thank You Fog* as well as his self designated posthumous poems The main text presents the poems in their original published versions The notes include the extensive revisions that he made to his poems over the course of his career and provide explanations of obscure references The first volume of this edition *Poems Volume I* 1927 1939 is also available [In Praise of Darwin](#) J. connecting thoughts into cumulative demonstrations But unlike Lucretius or Pope she cannot be accused of producing versified treatises Many of her poems are unsettling in their lack of conclusion their disparate insights often stand in conflict and her logic turns crucially on imagery juxtaposition assonance slant rhyme and punctuation The six chapters of this volume collectively argue that Dickinson is an epistemically ambitious poet who explores fundamental questions by advancing arguments that are designed to convince Dickinson exemplifies abstract ideas in tangible form and habituates readers into productive trains of thought she doesn't just make philosophical claims but demonstrates how poetry can make a distinct contribution to philosophy All essays in this volume drawn from both philosophers and literary theorists serve as a counterpoint to recent critical work which has emphasized Dickinson's anguished uncertainty her nonconventional style and the unsettled status of her manuscripts On the view that emerges here knowing is like cleaning mending and lacemaking L a form of hard ongoing work but one for which poetry is a powerful perhaps indispensable tool

Putnam, 2009-04-11 The lives of Catullus and Horace overlap by a dozen years in the first century BC Yet though they are the undisputed masters of the lyric voice in Roman poetry Horace directly mentions his great predecessor Catullus only once and this reference has often been taken as mocking In fact Horace's allusion far from disparaging Catullus pays him a discreet compliment by suggesting the challenge that his accomplishment presented to his successors including Horace himself In *Poetic Interplay* the first book length study of Catullus's influence on Horace Michael Putnam shows that the earlier poet was probably the single most important source of inspiration for Horace's Odes the later author's magnum opus Except in some half dozen poems Catullus is not technically writing lyric because his favored meters do not fall into that category Nonetheless however disparate their preferred genres and their stylistic usage Horace found in the poetry of Catullus whatever its mode of presentation a constant stimulus for his imagination And despite the differences between the two poets Putnam's close readings reveal that many of Horace's poems echo Catullus verbally thematically or both By illustrating how Horace often found his own voice even as he acknowledged Catullus's genius Putnam guides us to a deeper appreciation of the earlier poet as well Classical Presences in Irish Poetry after 1960 Florence Impens, 2018-01-02 This book provides the first overview of classical presences in Anglophone Irish poetry after 1960 Featuring detailed studies of Seamus Heaney Michael Longley Derek Mahon and Eavan Boland including close readings of key poems it highlights the evolution of Irish poetic engagements with Greece and Rome in the last sixty years It outlines the
