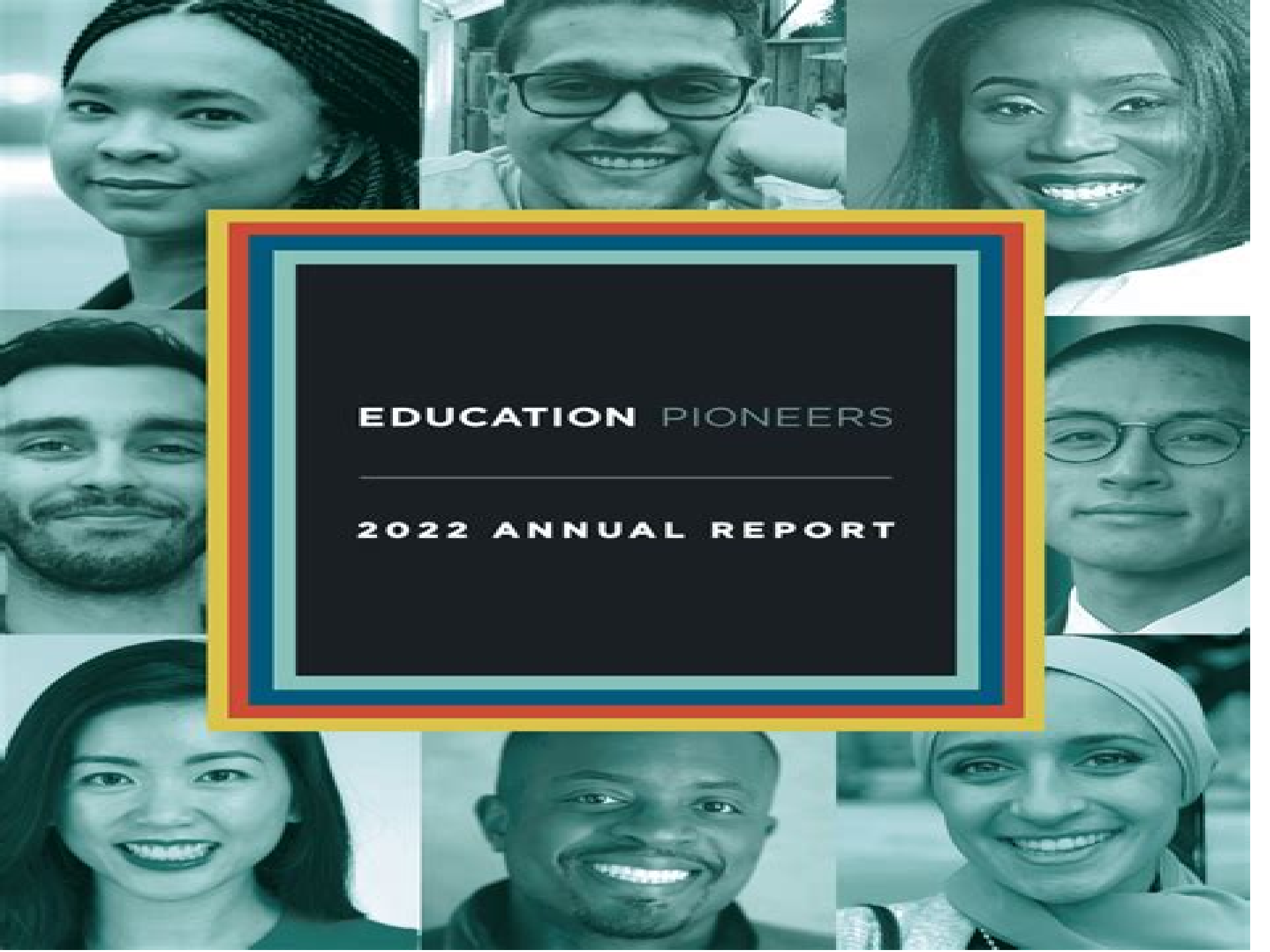

At first glance, the Ford Foundation and the Black Power movement would make an unlikely partnership. After the Second World War, the renowned Ford Foundation was the largest philanthropic organization in the United States and was dedicated to projects of liberal reform. Black Power ideology, which promoted self-determination over color-blind assimilation, was often characterized as radical and divisive. But Ford Foundation president McGeorge Bundy chose to engage rather than confront Black Power's challenge to racial liberalism through an ambitious long-term strategy to foster the social development of racial minorities.
