Ancient: A long time ago, before modern technology and tools

Geography

Ancient Egypt was in Northwest Africa.
The Nile River was the "source of life" in Ancient Egypt.
The Nile River provided fertile soil and water for farming.

Government

Egypt was ruled by pharaohs, who were powerful leaders. Pharaohs were seen as gods on Earth.

Economy

The Nile helped Egyptians grow crops like wheat and flax. They traded wheat for things like gold and timber. Timber was used to build boats, which allowed them to sail the African coast and expand their trading industry.

Art & Culture

Egyptians were using hieroglyphs (picture writing). The Rosetta Stone helped people figure out the meaning of hieroglyphs. Egyptians believed in many gods (polytheism), like Ra (sun god) and Isis (goddess of magic).

Contributions & Innovations

Egyptians used math and astronomy to make a 365-day calendar and a clock. Egyptians made paper from papyrus to print along the Nile.

Architecture

Egyptians built pyramids as tombs for pharaohs. They used ramps and levers to move big stones. The Great Sphinx is a famous sphinx with a lion's body and a man's head. It was built to guard the pyramids.
