<u>Procedure</u>: Find and record the mass of cup A. With cup A still on the scale, add approximately 10.0 g of baking soda to the cup. The mass does not have to be exact, as long as you carefully record your results.

Place cup B on the scale, weigh and record approximately 50.0 g of vinegar. The mass does not have to be exact, as long as you carefully record your results.

Slowly add vinegar to cup A until the reaction has stopped. DO NOT add all of the vinegar, just enough to complete the reaction. Reweigh and record both cup A and B. Calculate the mass of CO₂ that escaped.
