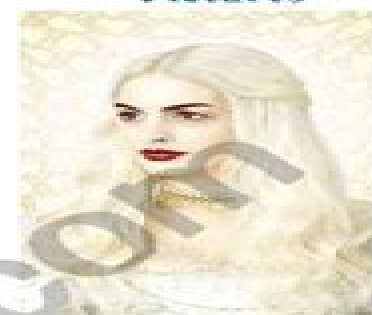


Alice in Wonderland
