The circulatory system is a network of blood vessels that transport blood throughout the body. It is divided into two main parts: the pulmonary circulation and the systemic circulation.

Pulmonary Circulation: This is the part of the circulatory system that carries oxygenated blood from the lungs to the heart and deoxygenated blood from the heart to the lungs.

Systemic Circulation: This is the part of the circulatory system that carries oxygenated blood from the heart to the body and deoxygenated blood from the body back to the heart.
