and numeracy questions This is then followed by four practice tests for numeracy four practice tests for reading and four practice tests for language conventions There is a sample writing task and four practice writing tasks Samples can be revised if the practice tests are not completed This is not an officially endorsed publication of the NAPLAN program and is produced by Pascal Press independently of Australian governments
