Characters: Who is in the story? What are their traits and roles?
Setting: Where and when does the story take place?
Plot: What happens in the story? Key events and sequence.
Conflict: What is the main problem or challenge faced by the characters?
Resolution: How is the conflict resolved?

STRUCTURE OF A NARRATIVE

Introduction: Set the scene and introduce the characters.
Body: Develop the plot with a sequence of events.
Conclusion: Wrap up the story and provide closure.

WRITING TIPS

Descriptive Language: Use vivid details to create a clear picture.
Engaging Dialogue: Make conversations between characters realistic and purposeful.
Show, Don't Tell: Illustrate actions and emotions through descriptions rather than just stating them.

Narrative Voice: Establish a unique voice or perspective for your story.
