



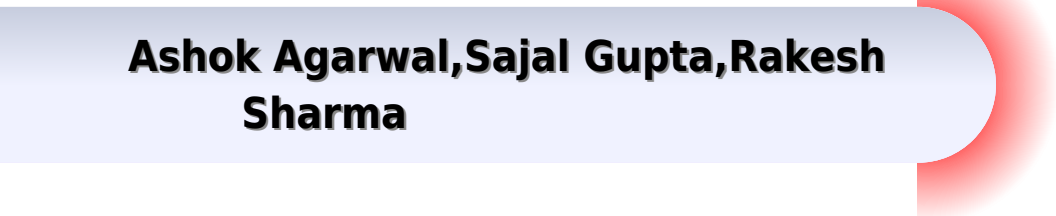

Ashraf,Jennifer Apsan,2025-06-18 Type 1 diabetes T1D is a disease marked by persistent hyperglycemia due to an autoimmune destruction of the pancreatic cells T1D is associated with severe short and long term complications and places a heavy burden on the health of the subjects and the national healthcare budget Following the diagnosis of T1D there is a relative period of endogenous insulin production called the honeymoon period or the phase of partial clinical remission PR when clinical and biochemical interventions could alter the trajectory of T1D Research indicates that disease modifying therapies that prolonging the PR

phase of T1D by preserving cell function may reduce the severity of the long term complications of T1D These interventions to preserve the cells of the pancreas have however had limited protection with successful therapies showing 15-20% effect size in preserving cell survival in the first year of the trials while the impact of other agents have been limited by severe side effects Ongoing trials with newer agents either as monotherapies or in combination are aimed at building on the effectiveness of existing agents Other studies in the field of disease modification seek to determine the scope and characteristics of PR by investigating parameters such as lifestyle clinical and demographic factors that impact the survival of cells This Research Topic is focused on disease modifying approaches in the study of T1D These approaches are not limited to the PR phase but span stages I-III of the disease Thus the scope includes approaches that seek to i clarify the determinants of PR ii prolong PR by various mechanisms iii reduce the predisposing factors to long term complications of T1D such as significant augmentation of time in range of glycemia We invite manuscripts on original research full and mini reviews and systematic reviews on content related to A Disease modifying approaches to reduce the complications of T1D B Mechanistic studies of disease modifying interventions in T1D C Clinical applications of disease modifying approaches to reduce the complications of T1D D Hypothesis and new thinking on disease modifying approaches in T1D

The ability of pathogens such as parasites bacteria fungi and viruses to invade persist and adapt in both invertebrate and vertebrate hosts is multifactorial and depends on both pathogen and host fitness Communication between a pathogen and its host relies on a wide and dynamic array of molecular interactions Through this constant communication most pathogens evolved to be relatively benign whereas killing of its host by a pathogen represents a failure to adapt Pathogens are lethal to their host when their interaction has not been long enough for adaptation Evolution has selected conserved immune receptors that recognize signature patterns of pathogens as non self elements and initiate host innate responses aimed at eradicating infection Conversely pathogens evolved mechanisms to evade immune recognition and subvert cytokine secretion in order to survive replicate and cause disease The cell signaling machinery is a critical component of the immune system that relays information from the receptors to the nucleus where transcription of key immune genes is activated Host cells have developed signal transduction systems to maintain homeostasis with pathogens Most cellular processes and cell signaling pathways are tightly regulated by protein phosphorylation in which protein kinases are key protagonists Pathogens have developed multiple mechanisms to subvert important signal transduction pathways such as the mitogen activated protein kinase MAPK and the nuclear factor κ B NF κ B pathways Pathogens also secrete effectors

that manipulate actin cytoskeleton and its regulators hijack cell cycle machinery and alter vesicular trafficking This research topic focuses on the cellular signaling mechanisms that are essential for host immunity and their subversion by pathogens

Goodwin,Catarina Magalhães,Anaïs Lacoursière-Roussel,2023-12-14 A decade of technological advances and research on the human microbiome has re defined our understanding of biological systems and now offers diagnostic tools and new approaches to human health Likewise marine ecosystems are driven by their microbiome the ensemble of microscopic organisms that inhabit the water column sediments and aquatic organisms and regulate most fluxes of energy and matter While the human microbiome is composed principally of bacteria the marine microbiome has a much broader ensemble of microscopic organisms with sizes spanning from viruses of a few tens of nanometres to metazoans of several centimetres Advances in high throughput imaging and sequencing are emerging in aquatic science providing important insights into ecosystem structure and functions and contributing to develop new indicators of ecosystem health and potential hazards to living resources and humans A number of research exploration and monitoring programs such as the Tara Oceans global expedition and the Marine Biological Observing Network MBON and the rising popularity of environmental DNA eDNA already led to a wealth of data However the wide range of methodologies used in this early exploration phase poses a challenge to integrative studies prompting community responses such as the Genomic Standards Consortium This Research Topic will foster cross community exchange of standards and best practices It is an opportunity for the different communities working on marine microbiomes to discuss the advantages and the limitations of their sampling and analysis methods The collection of papers will constitute a knowledge base aimed at 1 addressing the integration of existing observations from heterogenous methods and data types and 2 working towards cross communities standards and best practices for future observations and experiments This Research Topic will publish comprehensive methodological papers that review a sufficiently large body of field or experimental work Supporting meta data such as environmental context sampling materials sample treatments extraction and imaging yields must be provided and should preferably be uploaded to an online sample registry such as BioSamples Protocols and analytical methods should preferably be uploaded to an online repository such as Protocols io We welcome contributions from communities working in different environments focus on marine systems but also interested in estuarine and freshwater systems coastal open ocean and deep sea regions benthic pelagic and aerosol
