important No particular computer algebra package is discussed but a number of the exercises are intended to be solved using one of these packages chosen by the reader The approach is pure mathematical and the intended readership is undergraduate mathematicians also anyone who requires a more than basic understanding of the subject This book will be most useful for a second course in linear algebra that is for students that have seen some elementary matrix algebra But as all terms are defined from scratch the book can be used for a first course for more advanced students
