

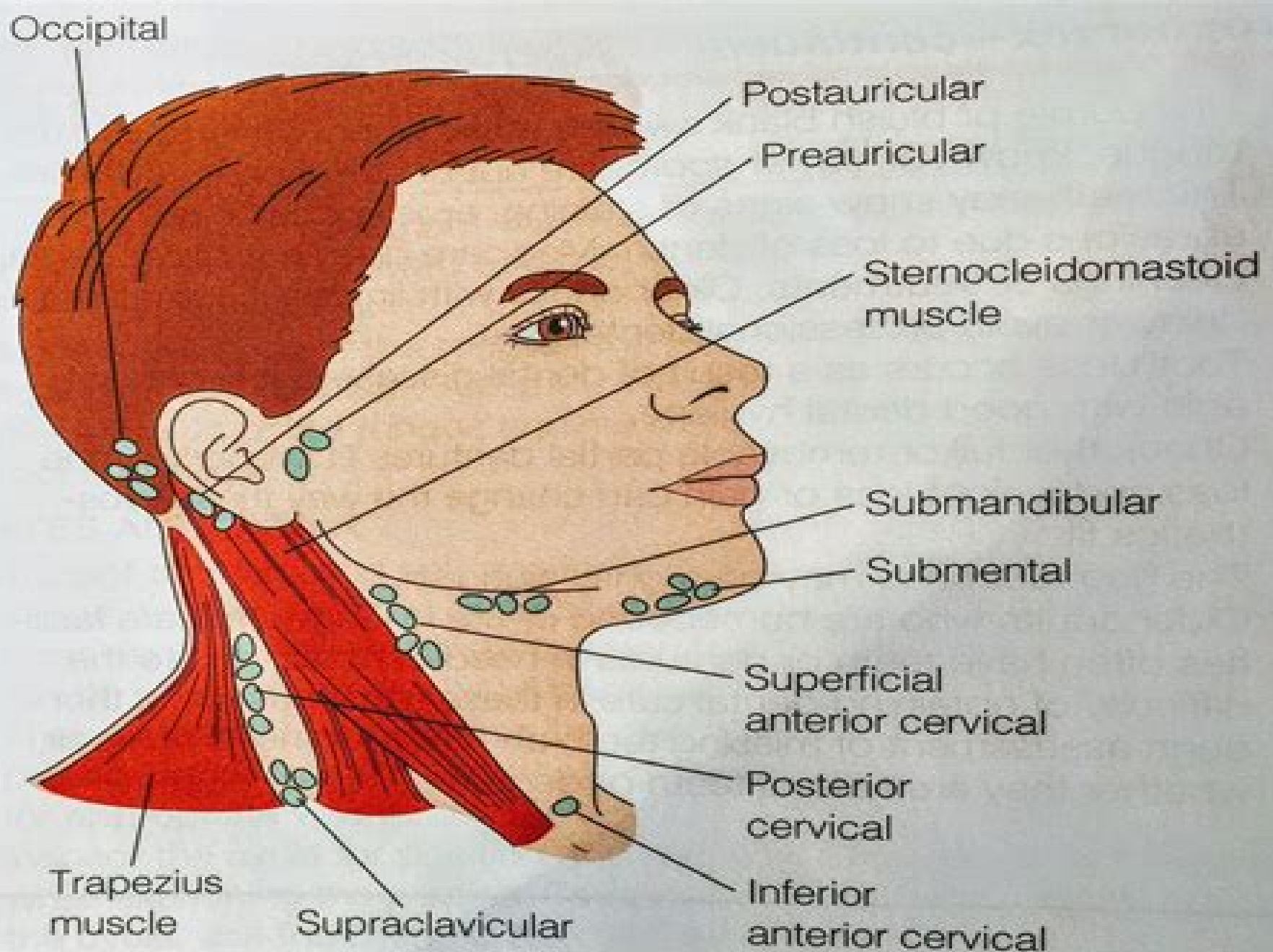


Figure 30-20 ■ Lymph nodes of the neck.
